

**FEE REDUCTIONS:**

The **CCS ( Child Care Subsidy )** was introduced by the Australian Government on 2nd July 2018 to help families with the cost of child care and early childhood education .



**There are three things which determine a family’s level of Child Care Subsidy:**

- 1) Combined family income
- 2) Activity Level of parents -The higher the level of activity, the more hours of subsidised care families can access .
- 3 )Type of child care service used.

Parents need to provide their information and **confirm** their child’s enrolment using their centrelink online account through **myGov**. For more information on

**Parents also need to complete :**

- ◆ **Eastside Enrolment form—providing a CRN (customer reference number) and date of birth or both the parent and child**
- ◆ **Eastside ‘Written Enrolment Arrangement ‘ form.**
- ◆ **Provide an up to date Medicare immunisation record for their child**

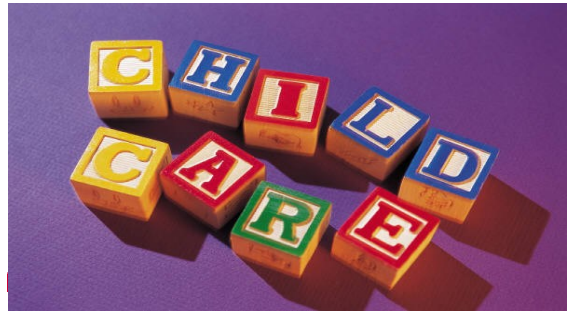

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# Quality Early Childhood Education at Quirindi Eastside

Quirindi Eastside child care centre staff use the National Early Years Framework ( EYLF) to develop learning programs for the children attending Eastside, children are offered a full educational early childhood program developed around each child's developmental needs, interests and abilities.

The EYLF is based around five play based learning outcomes which educators plan and evaluate, reflecting on practices and procedures to provide the best possible outcomes and learning environment for the children attending Eastside.

Play interactions are a young child's way of developing an understanding of the world . Through play young children develop a strong sense of identity, become connected with and contribute to their world, develop a strong sense of wellbeing, become confident and involved learners and become effective communicators ( EYLF outcomes).

The children at Eastside are divided into three aged learning groups.

Nursery - 0-2 year olds

Two to Three year old room

Three to Five years Preschool / School Readiness



Eastside also offers limited places for school aged children up till twelve years of age for afterschool and vacation care

At Eastside we see each child and their family as unique and aim to foster and develop individuality and the right of each child and family to experience a strong sense of belonging and inclusion.

### What your child Needs to bring for a day at Quirindi Eastside:

To ensure your child's comfort at Quirindi Eastside we suggest you send the following:

- a smiling face.
- a small school bag.
- 4 to 6 pairs training pants / nappies if not toilet trained
- Lunch and enough food for a whole day ( we encourage a nutritional lunch and encourage the development of good for kids good for life program and healthy eating)
- a piece of fruit -please place it out into the fruit basket upon arrival.
- Water to drink- extra drinks in summer. ( Water is encouraged for dental hygiene)
- A hat - A broad brim hat is preferred
- A Jumper for changing weather conditions
- Play clothes, clothes which allow freedom of movement , ease of toileting , clothes for messy interactive PLAY.
- At least one spare change of clothes in child's bag.
- Set of cot sheets, comforters , a blanket for winter , pillow, etc In pull string bag or pillowcase for hygiene; (Sheets are provide by the centre for Nursery children)
- Up to date Medicare immunization record
